- Safely recruit, train and support all those with any responsibility for children, young people and adults to have the confidence and skills to recognize and respond to abuse.
- Ensure that there is appropriate insurance cover for all activities involving children and adults undertaken in the name of Emmanuel Chinese Church.
- Display in church premises and on website the details of who to contact if there are safeguarding concerns or support needs.
- Listen to and take seriously all those who disclose abuse.
- Take steps to protect children and adults when a safeguarding concern of any kind arises, including notifying statutory agencies immediately.
- Offer support to victims/survivors of abuse regardless of the type of abuse, when or where it occurred.
- Care for and monitor any member of the church community who may pose a risk to children and adults whilst maintaining appropriate confidentiality and the safety of all parties.
- Ensure that health and safety policy, procedures and risk assessments are in place and that these are reviewed annually.
- Review the implementations of the Safeguarding Policy, Procedures and Practices at least annually.

Each person who works within this church will agree to abide by this policy and the guidelines established by this church.
